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1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (“MFRS”) 134 “Interim Financial Reporting” and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group’s audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2025. This interim financial report also complies with International Accounting Standards 34 “Interim Financial Reporting” issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted for this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2025 except for the adoption of MFRSs, amendments and interpretations that are effective for financial year beginning on or after 1 July 2025 which are applicable to the Group. The initial adoption of these applicable MFRSs, amendments and interpretations do not have any material impact on the financial statements of the Group.

2. Qualification of audit report of the preceding annual financial statements

The audit report for the preceding annual financial statements was not qualified.

3. Seasonality or cyclicity of interim operations

There has been no material seasonal or cyclical factor affecting the results of the quarter under review.

4. Nature and amount of items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence

There were no items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date.

5. Changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior interim periods of the current financial year or in prior financial years

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in the prior financial years.

6. Issuances, cancellations, repurchases, resale and repayments of debt and equity securities

(a) There were no additional shares bought back during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date. The total number of shares bought back as at 31 December 2025 was 10,486,468 shares and the shares are being held as treasury shares in accordance with the requirement of Section 127 of the Companies Act 2016.

(b) There were no additional shares purchased by the Executive Share Scheme (“ESS”) Trusts during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date. During the financial year-to-date, a total of 462,463 ordinary shares in the Company (“MPI Shares”) held in the ESS Trusts were transferred to eligible executives of the Group arising from the vesting of free MPI Shares pursuant to the ESS. As at 31 December 2025, the total number of MPI Shares held by the ESS Trusts was 482,639 MPI Shares.

Subsequent to the quarter under review, ESS Trust purchased 30,600 MPI Shares and transferred 26,789 MPI Shares to eligible executives of the Group arising from the vesting of free MPI Shares pursuant to the ESS.

Other than as mentioned above, there were no issuance of shares, shares cancellation, resale of treasury shares or repayment of debt or equity securities during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date.

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7. Dividend paid

During the financial year-to-date, the Company paid an interim single tier dividend of 10.0 sen per share amounted to RM19.9 million on 19 December 2025.

9. Material events not reflected in the financial statements

There are no material subsequent events to be disclosed as at the date of this report.

10. Changes in the composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the quarter under review, including business combinations, acquisition or disposal of subsidiaries and long-term investments, restructurings and discontinuing operations.

Subsequent to the quarter under review, the Company had on 4 February 2026 completed the acquisition of the entire issued and paid-up share capital of Infineon Technologies (Thailand) Limited ("Sale Shares") from Spansion LLC, Spansion, Inc. and Infineon Technologies Americas Corp. (formerly Cypress Semiconductor Corporation) for a Closing Purchase Price of USD76,938,000. The Purchase Price for the Sale Shares is subject to further post-completion adjustment if required, pursuant to the terms of the share purchase agreement. Upon completion of the acquisition, Infineon Technologies (Thailand) Limited ("IFTH") became a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company. IFTH has changed its name to Carsem Semiconductor (Bangkok) Ltd.

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11. Review of performance

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM626.6 million against the corresponding quarter of the last financial year of RM530.5 million. Revenue for the Asia, USA and Europe segments were higher by 14%, 54% and 8% respectively against the corresponding quarter of the last financial year. Profit before taxation ("PBT") was RM81.2 million as compared with RM58.7 million in the corresponding quarter of the last financial year. The higher PBT was mainly due to higher volume which resulted in higher revenue and better gross profit margin.

The Group's revenue for the financial year-to-date was RM1,261.5 million, 20% higher as compared with the revenue of RM1,047.1 million for the corresponding period of the financial year ended 30 June 2025 ("FY25"). Revenue for the Asia, USA and Europe segments were higher by 21%, 37% and 10% respectively against the corresponding period of FY25. PBT for the financial year-to-date closed at RM159.5 million against RM99.1 million for the corresponding period of FY25. The higher PBT was mainly due to higher volume which resulted in higher revenue and better gross profit margin.

12. Material changes in profit before taxation against the immediate preceding quarter

Revenue for the quarter under review was RM626.6 million against the preceding quarter of RM634.8 million. Revenue for the Asia and Europe segments were lower by 1% and 4% respectively while revenue for the USA segment was higher by 2% against the preceding quarter. For the quarter under review, the Group recorded PBT of RM81.2 million as compared with RM78.3 million for the preceding quarter. The higher PBT was mainly due to improved gross profit margin.

13. Prospects

The global semiconductor industry continues to be affected by recent developments, including the imposition of U.S. tariffs on certain European countries, rising commodity prices, and the weakening of the U.S. dollar. Nonetheless, the Group's performance will continue to benefit from strong demand for AI servers and the recovery of the automotive segment. The Group remains steadfast in its cost-reduction initiatives to mitigate ongoing cost pressures.

17. **Corporate proposals**

There are no corporate proposals announced but not completed as at the date of this report other than as mentioned below:

Dynacraft Industries Sdn Bhd ("DCI"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, had on 12 February 2025 entered into a conditional sale and purchase agreement with Open DC PE2 Asset Sdn Bhd ("PE2") for the proposed disposal by DCI to PE2 of two parcels of land together with the buildings thereon located in Bayan Lepas, Pulau Pinang for a total cash consideration of RM140.0 million ("Proposed Disposal").

Accordingly, the property of the Proposed Disposal has been reclassified as asset held for sale on the Condensed Consolidated Statement of Financial Position as at 31 March 2025.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Proposed Disposal is expected to be completed in the first half of year 2026.

The basic earnings per ordinary share for financial year-to-date is calculated by dividing the Group's profit attributable to owners of the Company of RM110,141,000 (FY25: RM70,160,000) and the weighted average number of ordinary shares during the period of 198,818,672 (FY25: 199,306,769).
